<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The nursery is open 5 days a week from 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., except for bank holidays and one week at Christmas. (We do not charge for Bank Holidays or our closure at Christmas) All fees to be paid by the 7th of each month. Invoices will be emailed by the 1st of the month (if this falls on the weekend then the first Monday back) Absences and sickness - this will be charged at the full rate as the place will be reserved. Sibling discount of 5% for joint attendance will be applied to the eldest child- not applicable to funded sessions Minimum sessions of 2 full days or 3 half days per week. Registration fees will be charged on the first invoice and covers administration and settling in sessions. Four weeks notice will be required for any changes to sessions or cancellation of place. Minimum booking of 2 full days or 3 half days per week. The nursery offers option of enrolling as term- time or full year. The Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE) provides eligible children with up to 30 free hours Monday to Friday. Any additional hours are charged at our additional hourly rate as stated. Please note that a full, up to date and signed PSOU must be completed before an eligible claim can be made. Our prices are reviewed annually on the 1st of April. 		

Funded Sessions Fees

Additional Service Charge- This will be applied to all sessions where government funding is utilised. Whilst the government funding is a great help towards childcare fees, it only covers a limited number of hours and is a basic entitlement to cover childcare only. This service is included in the session cost and removes the need for parents to supply consumables, ensuring that every child has access to high-quality provisions throughout the day.

This charge covers essential items and additional enrichment opportunities that are not included in the funded entitlement, as outlined in government policy.

Our enrichment activities provide valuable experiences for children and may include:

- Visits to local areas such as supermarkets, libraries, care homes, and the country park.
- Sessions led by external providers, such as sports sessions, music and movement classes, and other specialist activities designed to support children's development
- In-house activities celebrating seasonal celebrations and special events, such as Easter, Ramadan, Christmas, Diwali, Pancake Day, baking sessions, and parent/grandparent stay-and-play events.

Additionally, we provide nutritious, home-cooked meals made from quality ingredients, including breakfast, lunch, tea, and a morning snack.

The charge also includes essential childcare items such as nappies, wipes, and nappy sacks.

This charge is optional. Parents may choose alternative sessions that are provided completely free of charge; however, availability for these sessions is limited. Please contact us for more details.
